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ITINERARY

GRAND WASH CLIFFS

Logistics: This is a llama camping trip. Participants will assemble in St. George, Utah. Motel information will follow.

Emphasis: Colorado Plateau, Basin & Range geologic transition zone. Colorado Plateau, Mohave, and Sonoran flora & fauna transition zone. Small Ancestral Pueblo archaeological sites.

ON THE NIGHT BEFORE THE TRIP: Group assembles at designated motel in St. George, Utah. We plan to set aside rooms at the Hampden Inn sometime in February. The room, dinner and breakfast are at the participants expense.

DAY; Group assembles at the motel after breakfast and boards 4-wheel drive vans at 7:30 AM for trip to the trailhead. Drive is approximately 3.5 hours. Llamas are packed and we're on the trail. Hike to our base camp in the Grand Wash Wilderness, approximately 5.5 miles. Lunch at trailhead or on the trail.

DAY 2 & 3: Day hike from base camp to view geology, flora, fauna, and archaeological sites. Daily hikes approximately 6 miles. Lunch individually packed and carried.

DAY 4: Breakfast, break camp, load llamas, and return to the trailhead. Board vans and return to St. George. Arrival time in St. George approximately 5 PM. Lunch at trailhead or on the trail.

Itinerary subject to change due to road and weather conditions, and time constraints without consultation or notice to participants at the discretion of Buckhorn staff.

Trip fare includes all meals from lunch on Saturday through lunch on Tuesday. Evening meals will include wine. If participants wish to bring their favorite adult beverage it should be packaged in plastic containers and will be accommodated as space permits.
