## ITINERARY

### JUMPUP TO KANAB CREEK KANAB CREEK WILDERNESS

DAY #1; Meet at the trailhead at the end of Forest Service Road #423 in Jumpup Canyon at the beginning of the Ranger Trail into Kanab Creek. This is the wilderness boundary. Dinner will be provided by Buckhorn.

DAY #2; After breakfast, break camp load llamas and proceed down Jumpup Canyon approximately 5.5 miles. Lunch on the trail. Make camp at Lower Jumpup Spring. There is rock art along the way.

DAY #3; OPTION #1; After breakfast and packing lunches, day hike east on the Esplanade Trail, down into Sowats Canyon to lunch at Mountain Sheep Spring. Return to base camp hiking up Jumpup Canyon to complete the circle. Round trip distance approximately 6 miles.

OPTION #2; After breakfast and packing lunches, break camp, pack llamas and hike west on the Esplanade Trail to a camp at water pockets approximately 4 miles. Lunch on the trail. This is a minimal camp. We will pack only what we need based on the weather. Rock art and small ruins are evident on this part of the Esplanade.

DAY #4; OPTION #1; After breakfast and packing lunches, day hike to rock art and small ruins east on the Esplanade Trail. Lunch on the trail. Return to base camp at Lower Jumpup Spring. Round trip distance approximately 6 miles.

OPTION #2; After breakfast and packing lunches, break camp, pack llamas. Lunch on the trail. Return to base camp at Lower Jumpup Spring approximately 4 miles.

DAY #5; After breakfast and packing lunches, break camp, pack llamas. Hike up Jumpup Canyon to the trailhead approximately 5.5 miles. Lunch on the trail.

This itinerary is subject to change by Buckhorn staff without consulting participants subject to conditions encountered on the trail.

Buckhorn will provide all meals from dinner on day #1 through lunch on day #5. Dinners will include box wine. If participants desire additional adult beverages they will provide their own. They will be accommodated as space and weight allows. Please repackage your beverages in well sealed, plastic containers. Cans and glass bottles cannot be allowed.
